## **Vaccination Station Changes on the Horizon**

YAVAPAI COUNTY, AZ., April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – Spectrum Healthcare, the local non-profit healthcare organization administering COVID-19 vaccine in Yavapai County, has announced changes at the Vaccination Station in Prescott Valley and Cottonwood. These changes include hours of operation, end dates and future vaccine availability.

### **PRESCOTT VALLEY**

As more and more places can offer the COVID 19 vaccine, demand at the vaccination stations continues to decrease. As a result, Spectrum is preparing to conclude its vaccination station operations.

Vaccinations will continue at the Findlay Toyota Center through Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. Then, beginning April 10<sup>th</sup> the Prescott Valley Vaccination Station will be permanently moved to the Arizona Dermatology Suite at 3001 North Main Street STE 1E, Prescott Valley, AZ, located in the Prescott Valley Town Center. All scheduling related questions can be answered by calling Spectrum's pop up call center at 928-414-8884, please do not call AZ Dermatology. The clinic will continue to operate three days per week, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday, from 8am to 4pm, offering first doses until April 17<sup>th</sup>, and second doses through May 15<sup>th</sup>. For individuals with an existing first or second dose vaccine appointment scheduled on Tuesday or Wednesday at the Prescott Valley Vaccination Station after April 10<sup>th</sup>, please feel free to walk in anytime during the updated hours/days of operation.

### **COTTONWOOD**

Beginning the week of April 12<sup>th</sup>, the Cottonwood Vaccination Station will be open Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8 AM to 4 PM until May 14<sup>th</sup>. The Cottonwood Vaccination Station will be closed Saturday through Tuesday. At this time, walk-ins are being accepted at the Vaccination Station during open hours.

For individuals with an existing first or second dose vaccine appointment scheduled on Monday or Tuesday at the Cottonwood Vaccination Station after April 11<sup>th</sup>, please feel free to walk in anytime during the updated hours/days of operation.

## **LOOKING AHEAD**

Spectrum Healthcare will continue administering COVID-19 vaccine at their facilities in Prescott, Cottonwood, and Camp Verde when the Vaccination Stations close. Additionally, Spectrum Anywhere Healthcare Teams will continue to mobilize into rural communities, local facilities, and individual homes.
